### Christian Rudolph Thieman Survived By Wife And Four Children

Services for Christian Rudolph Thieman, whose death occurred at 3:20 o'clock Thursday afternoon, were conducted Monday afternoon from the late residence on North Franklin street and in St. Peter's church by Rev. Henry C. Klutey. Burial was had in the Schwaberow cemetery, east of New Bremen.

A native of Germany, where he was born May 22, 1843, Mr. Thieman emigrated to this country with his parents, Henry and Margaret (Staupleberg) Thieman, as a youth of 11 years. Following his marriage to Lizetta Christine Seeman, he established a home on a farm near Kettlersville. The family then remained on the farm until about 10 years ago when it moved to New Bremen.

Mr. Thieman reached the age of 85 years, four months and five days. His death Thursday afternoon occurred suddenly and was caused by a stroke of apoplexy. Surviving members of the family include the widow, Mrs. Lizetta Thieman; two sons, Ewald Thieman, Baldwin, Mich., Leo Thieman, Delaware, O., and two daughters, Mrs. Barry Clausing, St. Marys, and Mrs. Fred Timmerman, New Bremen. Three children preceded the father in death. Mr. Thieman also leaves a brother, Gustave Thieman, New Bremen.
