Illness Claims Charles Liening

The Rev. John C. Brucker will celebrate the solemn requiem high mass at 10:30 a.m. Saturday for Charles H. Liening, 85, who died at his residence early Tuesday morning. The funeral rites will be conducted at St. Michael Catholic Church, Ft. Loramie, and burial will follow in the church cemetery.

Mr. Liening, who resided at 17 Louie Street, Ft. Loramie, had been ill with a heart condition for the past ten years.
