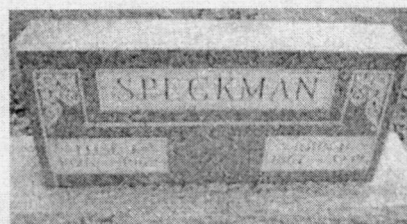

JOHN SPECKMAN

The sudden death of John H. Speckman, Friday evening, proved a distinct shock to his family members and his friends, he having appeared in his usual good health during the day. In the evening he had gone to the home of his son-in-law and daughter, Dr. and Mrs. M. H. Briggs South Washington street, where he was suddenly stricken with a cerebral hemorrhage which proved fatal at about 8:30 o'clock. His body was removed to the Vornholt funeral home, on East Monroe street, where services were conducted Monday afternoon by Rev. J. C. Melchert, and burial was made in the Willow Grove cemetery.

Mr. Speckman, a native of New Bremen, was a son of late Mr. and Mrs. Frederick Speckman, and was born January 8, 1867. He resided in New Bremen all his life, and years ago was a member of the mercantile firm of Speckman, Goll and Company, later joining in the merger which developed into the Arcade Department Store company where he has been a stockholder and a member of the board of directors until his death. In 1899 he married Lizzie Waterman who with six children survive. They are Mrs. Ed Freytag, Ft. Loramie; Lloyd Speckman, Washington, D. C.; Mrs. M. H. Briggs, Mrs. Reuben Wissman and Lewis Speckman, New Bremen; and Miss Roma Speckman, Dayton. There is also one sister, Mrs. Ferd Reiher, St. Marys, and one half-sister, Mrs. Caroline Jaeger, Dayton.
