

Anna Winhoven Rites Held Saturday

Mrs. Anna M. Winhoven, 65, wife of Bernard F. Winhoven, R. R. 1, Minster, Hegemann's Resort, died at 7:00 a.m. last week Wednesday in Joint Township Memorial Hospital, St. Marys.

Death, resulting from complications, followed an illness of three months.

Born August 27, 1900 in St. Henry, Ohio, a daughter of John and Wilmena Nietfield Stelzer, she had been a resident of Minster for the past 14 years, moving here from Mercer County.
