



Funeral Saturday For Paul Sturwold

Paul W. Sturwold, 40, of 520 East Main Street, Bradford, was found dead at 5 a.m. at his residence Wednesday, February 18. Sturwold had been ill for several years and death was due to an overdose of sleeping pills.

He was born December 22, 1929 a son of Henry and Marie Eck Sturwold. On September 13, 1952 he married the former Christine Veale who survives with four children, William, 16; Paul Jr., 14; David 11 and Christine Ann 7. Survivors also include two brothers, Orville of Oran and Jerome of Vandalia and one sister, Mrs. David (Darlene) Barthorst of Dayton.

Mr. Sturwold was an employee of the Miami County State Highway Department and a member of Immaculate Conception Church, Bradford and the Holy Name Society of the church. He served nine years in the service with the 817th Engineer Aviation, including one year in Panama and five years in England.

Funeral services were held Saturday at 10:30 a.m. in Immaculate Conception Church, Bradford, with the Rev. John Bolan officiating. Burial followed in the Bradford Cemetery.
