



Services For Agnes Kohnen To Be Friday

Requiem high mass will be sung in St. Augustine's church at 10:30 a. m. Friday for Mrs. Agnes Anna Kohnen, aged 76 years and seven months, widow of Henry J. Kohnen, who died shortly after 11 a. m. Tuesday. Rev. Fr. Otto Mueller will officiate, with burial to be in the church cemetery.

Mrs. Kohnen had been in failing health since October of 1945, and had been confined to bed since last Dec. 15 in her home at 123 North Main street where she resided with her son, Charles (Casey) Kohnen. Her death was attributed to complications.

A lifelong resident here, she was born Oct. 11, 1870, daughter of George and Anna Wente Watercutter. She married Mr. Kohnen Nov. 5, 1890, and he died Feb. 16, 1925. Four children also preceded her in death.

Surviving are the son, Charles; another son, Andrew; a daughter, Mrs. Marie Poespelman, and a daughter-in-law, Mrs. Frances Kohnen, all of here. There are 10 grandchildren.

A lifelong Catholic, Mrs. Kohnen received the last sacrament of the church. She was a charter member of the American Legion ladies' auxiliary here, and was a member of the Minister auxiliary of the Knights of St. John.
