GERHARD WATERMAN

Suffering ever since the first of the year from hardening of the arteries, John Gerhard Waterman was called to rest this morning at 4.30 at his home on North Walnut street. His ailment really began last fall, though he was always up and around until the first part of last January, since when he had been confined to the sickbed. At the time of death he attained the age of 68 years, 11 months and 11 days.

Our subject was born September 19th, 1849, on the farm now owned by Waterman Bros. west of town! He was reared to manhood on the farm and after attaining maturity. was joined in wedlock on May 4th 1871, to Miss Marie Sophie Hoff, the

surviving widow, for many years Mr. Waterman was one of the prominent coopers of New Bremen, a trade, which in its time offered a substantial income. About sixteen or seventeen years ago he abandoned the cooper's trade and entered cement contracting. He was also street commissioner for a span of twenty years and served as real estate appraiser and assessor for a long number of years. He was also identified with the Cataract Fire Company, having been placed on the retired list at his own request about two years ago. He was generally regarded as a straightforward and thoroughly honest citizen, respected and esteemed by a circle of acquaintances.

His marriage to his surviving widow gave issue to four children, namely Mrs. O. H. Boesel, Mrs. John Speckman and Louis Waterman of here and Wm. Waterman of Celina. Ten grandchildren, two sisters and one brother also survive. Funeral is announced to take place Sunday afternoon at 1:30 from the residence with services at 2 in St. Pauls church, Interment in the German Protestant cemetery. [N.B. Sun-8/30/1918]
