Dayton Rites Set For Native Minsterite

Harry A. Dillman, aged 67, a native of Minster and a resident of Dayton many years, died at 7:15 p. m. Wednesday at his residence in that city after a protracted illness.

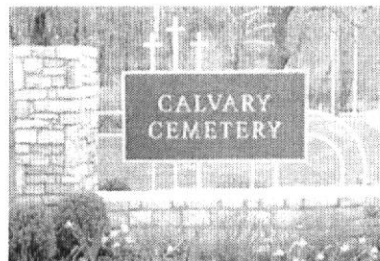
Funeral services have been arranged for 9 a. m. Saturday in Holy Family church in Dayton, with burial to follow in the church cemetery. The body is at the Meyer-Boehmer funeral home where friends may call until time of the rites.

Mr. Dillman was born here May 3, 1887. His parents were Herman and Philomena Haverbeck Dillman. He and Agnes Oldiges of Minster were married Oct. 12, 1910. He was a former employe of General Motors, Frigidaire division, and retired five years ago because of failing health.


Surviving him are his wife; a son, Walter; three daughters, Mrs. Richard [Jeanette] Osterday, Mrs. John [Dorothy] Pierr and Mrs. Robert [Betty Mae] Hecht; and 11 grandchildren, all of Dayton.

Six brothers and sisters of a family of 11 are living. They are Mamie Hughes of Detroit, Louis Dillman, Mathilda Jacobs and Rose Lyons, all of Springfield, and Andrew Dillman and Lomea Schweser, both of Minster.
