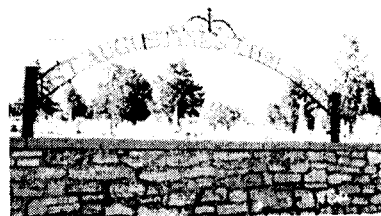

Former Minsterite Passes At Dayton

Funeral services will be held Saturday at 8:30 a. m. at the Luthman funeral home in Dayton and at 9 a. m. at Holy Rosary church there for Henry Donauer, 69, who died Tuesday at 2:30 p. m. at his home in that city after an illness of nine years of complications. Burial will be made in St. Augustine's cemetery here.

He was a native of Minster and the son of Jacob and Minnie (Luckman) Donauer. In his youth he was employed at the Minster Machine company here. He was employed 20 years in Cincinnati and lived 15 years in Dayton where he formerly was a tool grinder at Delco Products.

Surviving are the widow, the former Mary Busse to whom he was married here Oct. 27, 1909; two sons, Paul and Russell, and two daughters, Mrs. Wilson (Velma) McManown and Mrs. Robert (Ruth) Deshler, and eight grandchildren, all of Dayton; a sister, Mrs. Louise Albers of Cincinnati and two brothers, John of Cincinnati and Anton of here. A son was drowned here at the age of six. A sister, Mrs. Emma Mills of Cincinnati also is dead. [Minster Post-11/2/1951]
