A brother David is deceased.

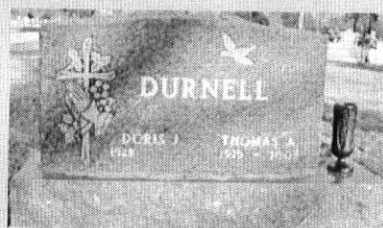

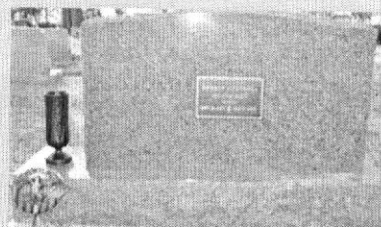
