## 115 Descendants Left By Mrs. Hilgefert

Mrs. Antoinette Hilgefert, 90, formerly of Ft. Loramie, died at 10:48 a. m. Monday at Wilson Memorial Hospital, Sidney. Bronchial pneumonia was the cause.

Mrs. Hilgefert had been a patient at the Morris Nursing Home, Sidney, from where she was taken to the hospital 10 days ago.

Mrs. Hilgefert was born May 12, 1871, in Cincinnati, daughter of John and Elisabeth Dressman Puthoff. She moved to Shelby County at an early age. On Jan. 25, 1899, she was married to Anthony Hilgefert who preceded her in death.

Surviving her are eight children, Mrs. Louis (Henrietta) Hoelscher, Henry and William Hilgefert, and Mrs. Harry (Arnolda) Wendeln, all of Ft. Loramie; Gilbert, Versailles; Mrs. William (Leona) Henke, Osgood; Matthias and Edwin Hilgefert, Ft. Loramie; 40 grandchildren, 67 great-grandchildren, and a brother, Clem Puthoff of Ft. Loramie.

She was a member of St. Michael's Church, Ft. Loramie, and the Altar society of the church.

Funeral services will be held at 9 a. m. Thursday at St. Michael's Church with the Rev. Clarence Leibold offering Requiem High Mass. Burial will be in the church cemetery. Friends may call at the Heim Funeral Home in Minster.
