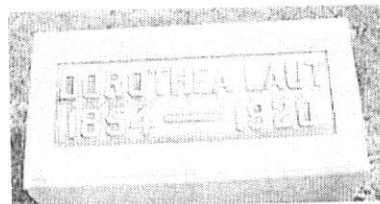

After a lingering illness extending over several months, most of which time she was able to be up and around, Mrs. Dorothy Laut, widow of the late Herman Laut, passed away at her home, corner of South Washington and Cherry streets, Monday at 1 a. m. According to medical advices death was due to cancer of the liver.

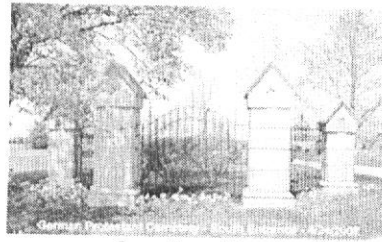
When quite young Mrs. Laut, nee Dorothy Purpus came to America with her parents from Germany. They settled immediately upon their arrival in New Bremen and when attaining maturity's estate, our subject was joined in marriage to Herman Laut, who on June 20th of last year through a sudden attack of heart failure came to an unexpected death. This union was blessed with eleven children, 8 of whom, four sons and four daughters survive their parents, namely Emil, Frank and Herman Laut of here, Robert Laut of Minster, Mrs. Dan Headapohl, 4 miles east of here, Mrs. Ralph Heffner of Colina, Mrs. Chas. Moore of Toledo and Miss Louise Laut, who resided at home with her mother. Aside from her children, deceased is survived by a sister, residing in Germany, another sister, Mrs. John Gemmer of Bippus, Ind., and a brother, Theodore Purpus of here. Mrs. Laut was possessed of admirable traits, kindly and loving not only to her immediate household, but also to those with whom she came in daily contact. Her departure will surely prove an irretrievable loss to those near and dear to her. Her age is given at 66 years, 8 months and 25 days.

Private funeral services were conducted Thursday morning by Roy Hönninger at the home. Friends were given an opportunity to view the remains Wednesday evening from 7 till 9. Interment was had in the German Protestant cemetery.
