J. H. Winkeljohn

CELINA—J. H. Winkeljohn, 91, retired Celina businessman, died at 7 a. m. Thursday in Gibbons Hospital after a long illness.

Born in Voilage, Germany, Mr. Winkeljohn came to this country at the age of 19. He lived in St. Henry several years, coming to Celina 60 years ago to found the Celina Lumber Co.

Mr. Winkeljohn was a member of Immaculate Conception Catholic Church and its Holy Name and Poor Souls societies.

Surviving are a son, Ferd, Celina; and five daughters, Mrs. Agnes Hierholzer, Sandusky; Mrs. George Weber, Delphos; and Lucille, Lihan and Rita, all at home; 11 grandchildren and 11 great-grandchildren, and a brother, August, Celina.

Services will be at 9 a. m. Saturday in Immaculate Conception Church, the Rev. Marcellus Fortman officiating. Burial will be in the church cemetery. Friends may call at the family residence after 7 p. m. Thursday Pulskamp Funeral Home is in charge of arrangements.
