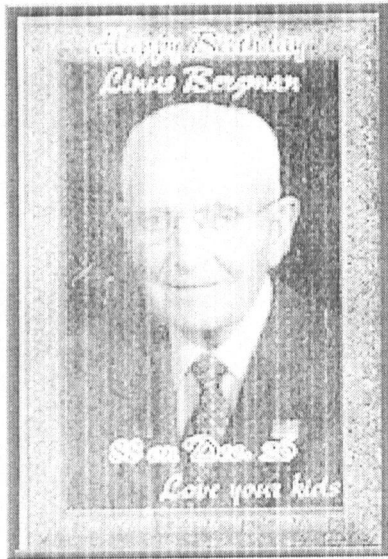


Linus Bergman
