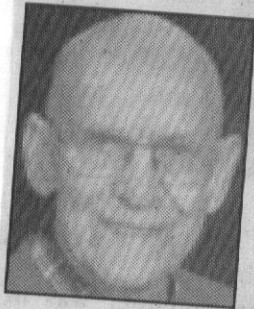


Allen A. Langenkamp
