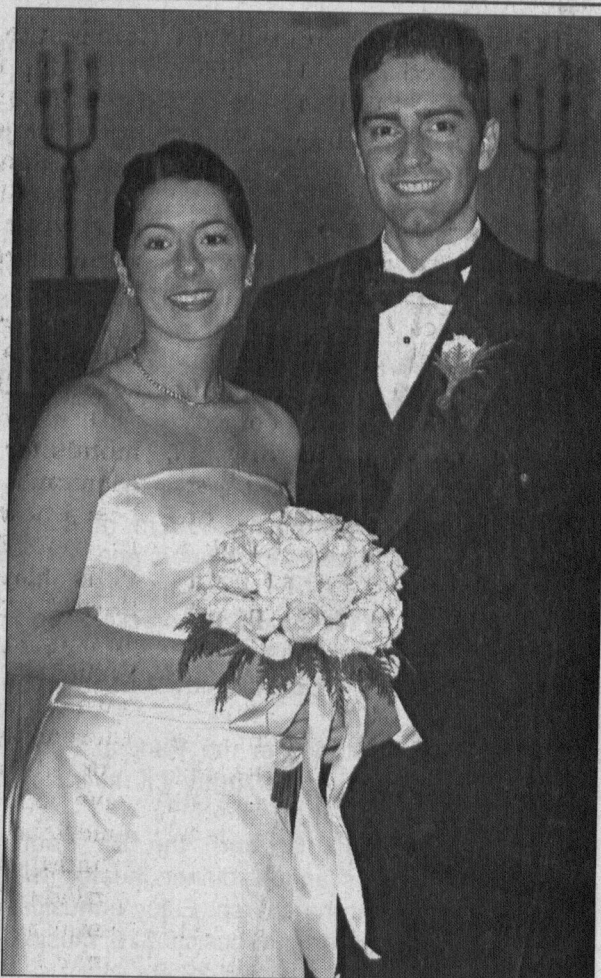
net colored satin gowns with V-back styling belted at the natural waist with satin. They carried red roses accented with cedar branches wrapped and tied with red satin ribbon.
