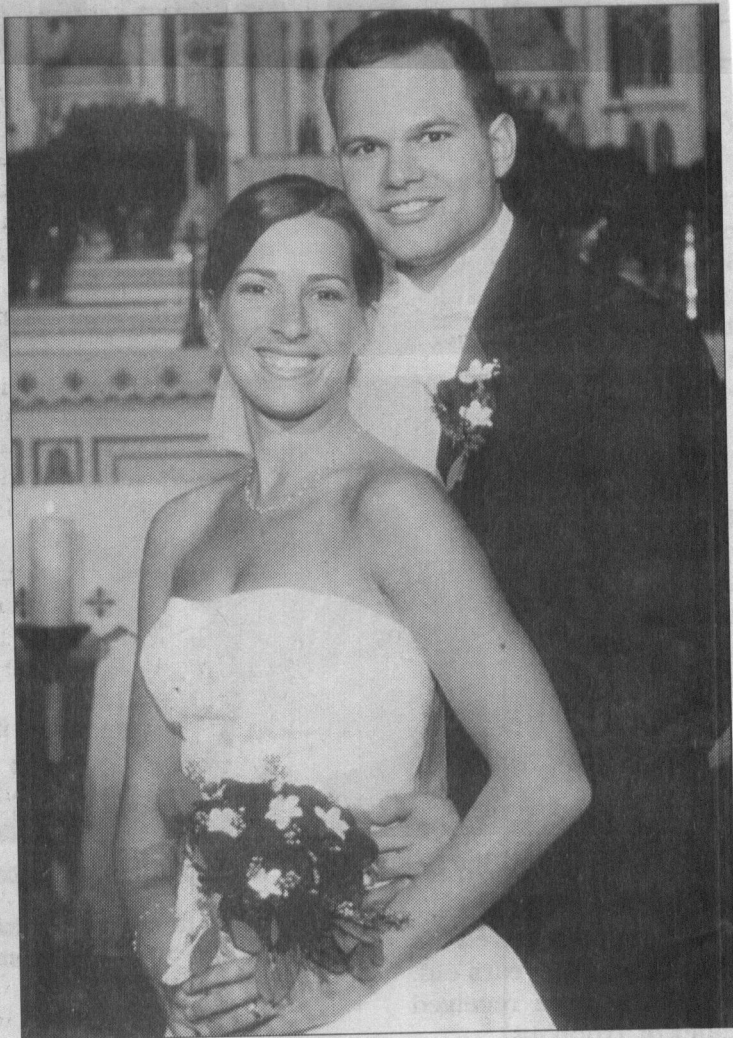
The bride is the daughter of Roger and Kathleen Brunswick, St Henry, and the groom is the son of Nicholas and Mary Prenger, Minster.
